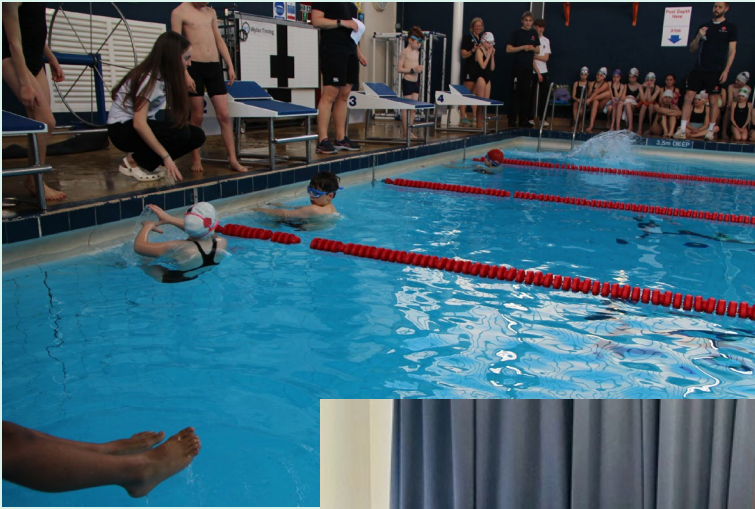

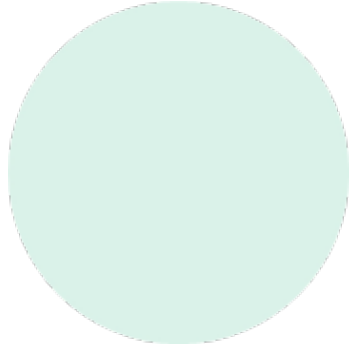
We remind pupils that screen time should be limited and all turned off an hour before bedtime – so their minds can slow down and prepare for sleep.

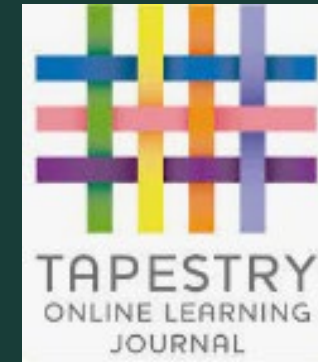
Tapestry is an App to encourage and promote parental engagement in the Infant School

Parents download the App and Teachers send notifications to Parents about their child at School

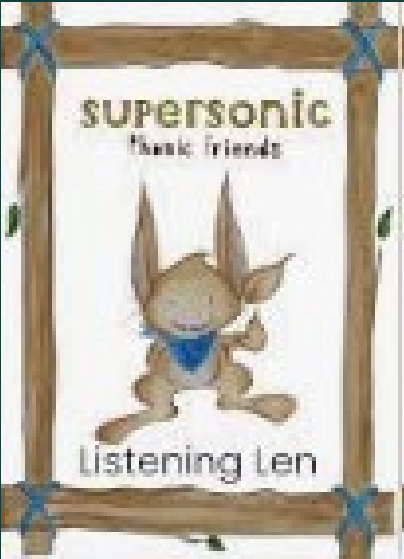

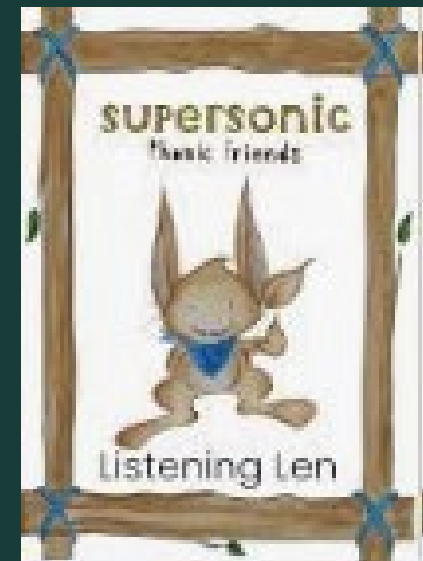

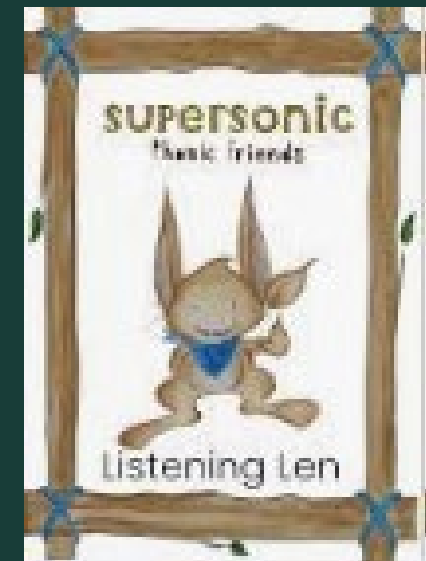
