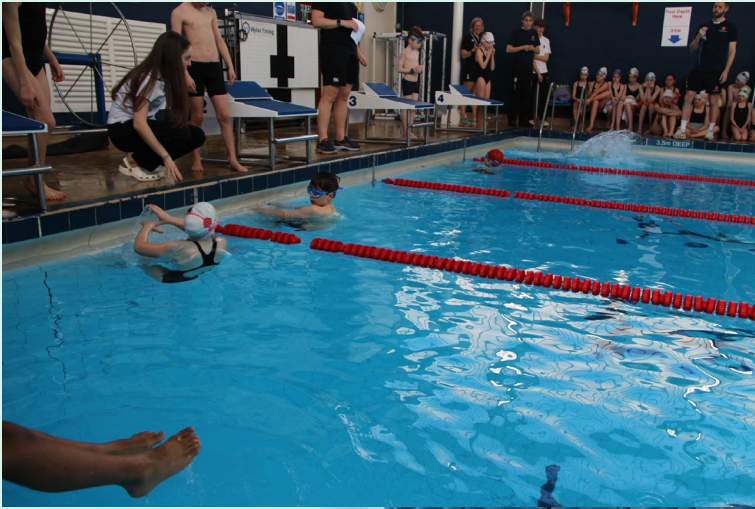


- Technology: These sessions take place either in the classroom or in specialist rooms. Sessions include food technology, woodwork, STEM activities and classroom-based design projects.

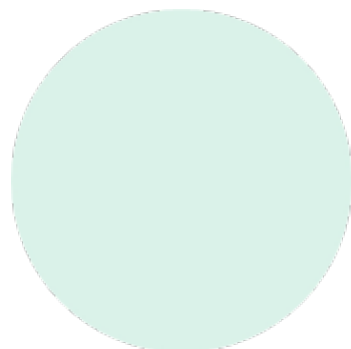
We remind pupils that screen time should be limited, and all turned off an hour before bedtime – so their minds can slow down and prepare for sleep.

School pick up is 3.35 prompt. If you are late, please do not worry as your child will be sent to Homework Room and will be available to collect from 4pm.

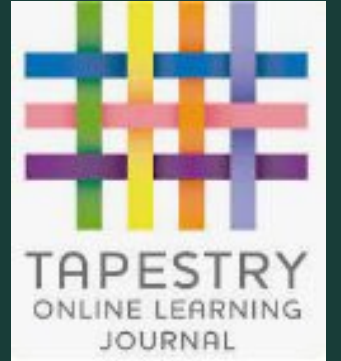
Homework Room: Held in classrooms and runs from 3.35 - 4.00pm – No booking and no early collection.
