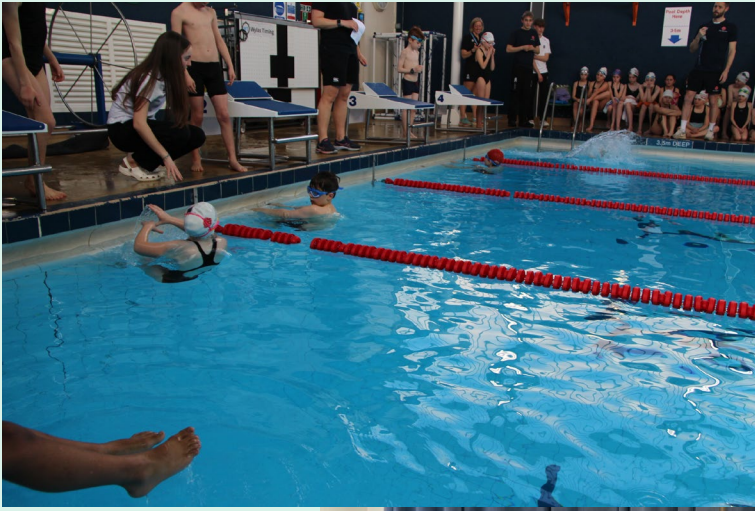

Pastoral /PSHE (RSE)

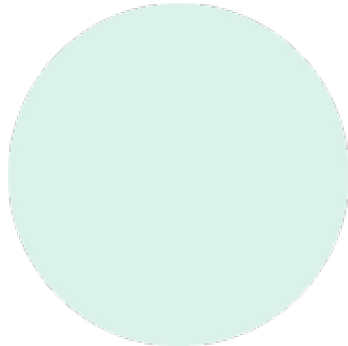
We remind pupils that screen time should be limited and all turned off an hour before bedtime – so their minds can slow down and prepare for sleep.
