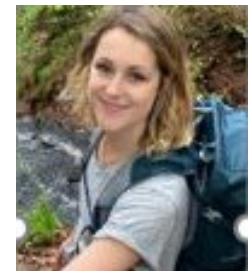

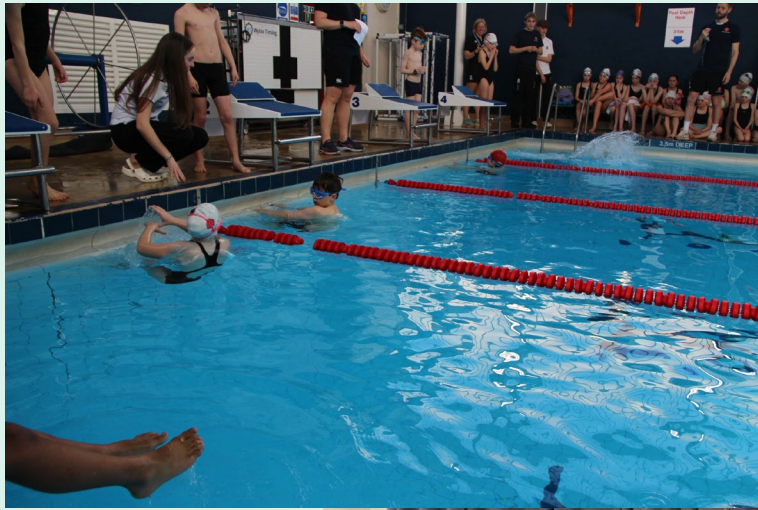


Adventure / Leadership / Technology

We remind pupils that screen time should be limited and turned off an hour before bedtime – so their minds can slow down and prepare for sleep.

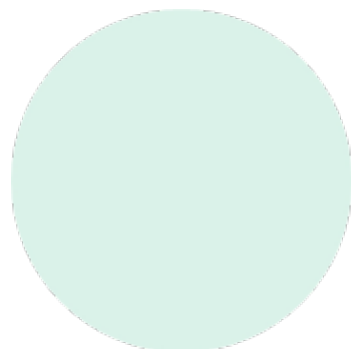
At school – we have tight security on our web access and teachers check websites before use wherever practical

Before and After School Provision

Before school:

Early Birds from 8am – 8.30 am on the Junior Playground. Enter through Hive gates or Main Drive and register with member of staff on duty

After School:

Homework Room: Held in classrooms and runs from 3.35 -4.00pm – No booking and no early collection

Co-Curricular Club: Various locations – start at 3.35pm – finishing time depends on type of club – often 4.15pm but this does vary.
