We remind pupils that screen time should be limited and all turned off an hour before bedtime – so their minds can slow down and prepare for sleep.


At school - we have tight security on our web access and teachers check websites before use wherever practical

Overview will be set on Microsoft Teams Tasks to be completed as directed but usually on paper Overview and tasks will be given out on a Monday to be handed in by the following Monday There will be 2 mathematics tasks - 1 online on Maths Shed and 1 in a booklet. Please contact the mathematics teachers with any queries over homework - their contact details will be on the first overview
