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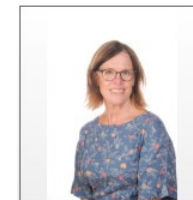

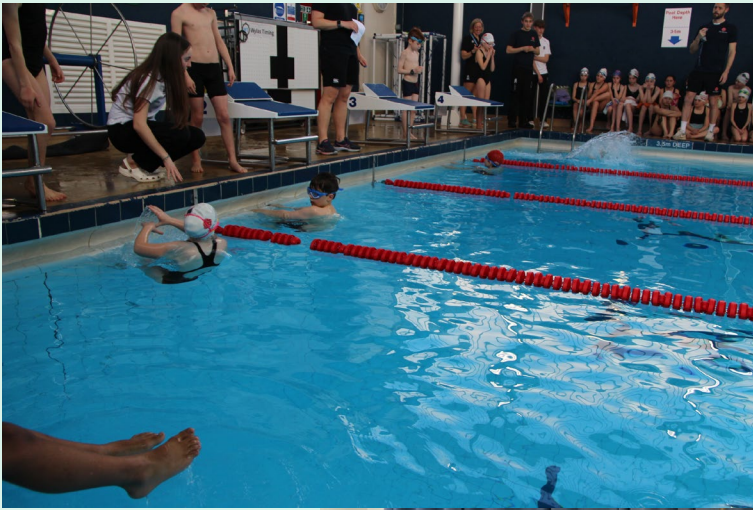
Adventure / Technology / Leadership

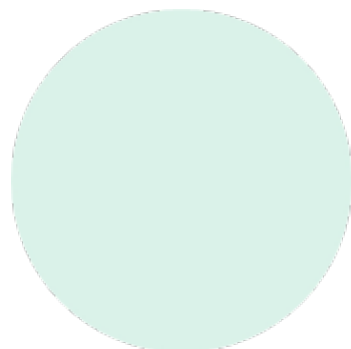
We remind pupils that screen time should be limited and all turned off an hour before bedtime – so their minds can slow down and prepare for sleep.

Before and After School Provision

Before School:

Early Birds from 8.00-8.20am in the Junior Playground. Enter through the Hive gates and your child needs to register with the member of staff on duty on the playground. If it is wet, please go into Rose Theatre.

Homework and iPads:

Overview will be set on Microsoft Teams

Tasks to be completed as directed but usually on paper

Overview and tasks will be given out on a Monday to be handed in by the following Monday

There will be 2 mathematics tasks – 1 online on Maths Shed and 1 in a booklet. Please contact the mathematics teachers with any queries over homework – their contact details will be on the first overview

All children in Year 6 will have their own iPad, but it remains in school. Children can use the iPad as directed during the day and in homework room. At the end of homework room it must be returned and placed on charge.

For the first 2 weeks, the overview will be printed for all the children until they are all secure logging into Teams at home. We will also check this with the children at school. Login for Teams will be their usual school login.
